Message from Fr Joe re volunteers in the parish

My thanks to all those who give of their time and talents to support the life and work of our parish. We are blessed to have so many willing volunteers who assist in a variety of ways and I am deeply grateful to you all.

The Catholic Safeguarding Standards Agency (CSSA) has policies and procedures for the recruitment of volunteers which all parishes in England and Wales must comply with.

In our parish we already have robust procedures when recruiting those whose role is eligible for a DBS check (Level 3)

Adult altar servers; Bereavement support

Catechists; Chaperones; Children's liturgy; Eucharistic Minsters to the housebound; Sacristan; SVP; Youth Club leaders.

However, we now need to formalise procedures for those whose role **does not** bring them into direct contact with children, young people or vulnerable adults.

(Level 1 - volunteers who work behind the scenes):

Church cleaners; finance committee members; flower arrangers; gardeners; money counters; other jobs I may not be aware of.

(Level 2 - those who carry out a visible role):

Altar server when children or young people are not present

Choir; Music group; Minister of the Eucharist in church; Minister of the Word; Repository; those who serve tea/coffee after Masses; Welcomers

If your role is deemed Level 1 or 2, please contact the parish office by **Monday 30th December** to confirm your intention to continue with this role in 2025. You will then receive a basic registration form which asks for minimal details e.g. emergency contact.

As parish priest, it is my responsibility to oversee all those who undertake any role in the life of the parish. Therefore, if you wish to volunteer for a role in the future, you will need to meet with me in the first instance to discuss your application and I will signpost you to the next steps. These procedures are designed to ensure the safety and well being of all and I look forward to your continuing cooperation.
